General Price List

These prices are effective as of **October 1, 2010**, but may be subject to change without notice.

In compliance with the trade regulations of the Federal Trade Commission (16 CFR Part 453), we are required to provide you this General Price List. The goods and services showed below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only those items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our services.

If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery or crematory services, flowers, newspaper notices, airline charges, certified copies of the death record etc. The process for those cash advance items will be shown on your bill or the statement describing the funeral goods and services that you selected.

Professional Services Of Funeral Director And Staff.....\$2,000

Our professional service charges include, but are not limited to the following: Consultation with family and clergy; arrangement and direction desired; preparation and filing of necessary notices, authorizations and consents; other services; and attendance prior to, during and following the funeral including coordination with those providing portions of the funeral (e.g. cemetery, crematory).

Embalming.....\$800

Except in certain special cases (see requirements of Michigan law set out below), embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require embalming, such as a direct cremation or direct burial. The law requires embalming when death was caused by certain infectious diseases, or with very limited exceptions, when body is not taken to its final destination (such as a cemetery or crematory) within 48 hours. This charge includes: **Other Preparations Of the Body.**

Other Preparations of the Body.....\$225

Services provided may include when necessary, but are not limited to the following: restoration, cosmetology, special care of Gift of Life donors, washing, disinfecting and manicuring when no embalming procedure is performed.

Use of Facility & Staff for Viewing.....\$595

Use of Facility & Staff for ceremony/rite/service.....\$395
Service inside or outside of funeral home

***Delayed Cemetery Service.....\$200**

This charge applies when there is a delay in the disposition of the deceased. This may occur due to the celebration of a Memorial or burial on another day.

Removal Service.....\$295

Transfer of remains to funeral home within **35 miles** the charge for additional miles is \$4.00 per mile

Hearse (Funeral Coach) Within a 25 mile radius.....\$265

Immediate Burials \$1795

Our charge for an immediate burial without any attendant rites or ceremonies includes; removal and shelter of the remains and local transportation to cemetery or crematory; necessary services of staff and authorizations.

Green Burial Option.....\$1795

This charge includes removal and shelter of the remains, necessary basic services of funeral director and staff, obtaining required authorizations, and local transportation (within 30 miles) to cemetery. It does not include the use of facilities or staff for viewing, visitation or ceremonies.

Direct Cremation.....\$1795

Our charge for direct cremation without any attendant rites or ceremonies includes: removal and/or shelter of remains, necessary services of staff and local transportation to crematory.

Professional Service for Disinterment.....\$400

Service includes application for disinterment, notarizing documents, filing documents with county, obtaining and delivering permits and a director at re-interment.

International Shipping Services.....\$475

This charge applies to all international shipping of remains. it is in addition to all other funeral expenses.

Airline/Shipping Containers.....\$250

Alternative Container.....\$195

Forwarding Remains to Another Funeral Home.....\$1995

This charge includes removal of remains, services of staff, embalming, necessary authorizations and local transportation to airport or railway. It does not include the services of staff or the use of facilities for any visitation and/or rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding of the body.

Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home.....\$1395

Services of funeral director and staff, care of remains, transportation of remains to funeral home from airport and to cemetery or crematory. This charge does not include the use of staff and facilities for visitation, rites and ceremonies, private viewing or any other merchandise not specifically listed.

Use of Facility For a Private Autopsy.....\$150

This charge includes the scheduling and arranging of a certified pathologist to perform post mortem operations as well as disinfecting the facility upon completion of the autopsy. Does not include pathologist's fee.

Body/Anatomical Donations.....\$690

Basic services for staff, funeral director, and facilities, removal and shelter of the remains, transportation to medical facilities, filing the death certificate; securing necessary permits and authorizations.

Insurance Assignment Fee.....4.5% of Bill

Our staff will assist you in securing the death benefit on valid life insurance policies and assigning funds to pay for the funeral service.
